
Reducing Communities' Vulnerability to Drought and External Shocks (Recover) in Somalia boosts farmer's access to equipment and skills for climate-smart production and opportunities for income diversification and market access (FAO)

Migrant Integration & Reintegration

<u>Scaling Durable Solutions and Urban Resilience</u> in Somalia works with local private and public actors to integrate IDPs through livelihoods, housing, and services (IOM)

Shamortha Plus Activity in Bangladesh works with two private sector food processing companies to offer skills training to job seekers, including returning migrant workers

Approaches to Climate and Migration



Address the drivers of migration by catalyzing climate adaptation, resilience and development across sectors

Enable pathways that **facilitate safe, regular, and orderly migration** for work that benefit communities of origin and destination and decrease the likelihood of irregular, unsafe migration

Strengthen migrant integration and reintegration including access to livelihood opportunities, education, health and social services to increase climate resilience and social and economic wellbeing

Enhance diaspora investment and remittance flows by supporting diaspora engagement and remittance sending
